

UKOUG - GDPR Statement of commitment to compliance

UK Oracle User Group takes the protection of our members and client's personal data very seriously and as such are committed to achieving compliance to data protection legislation under the General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) which are due to come into effect on the 25th May 2018.

We recently commissioned an in-depth GAP analysis from an independent GDPR practitioner. From this analysis we now have an action plan, so we can systematically address the recommendations to ensure we comply with GDPR at the earliest possible date.

Our current membership system does not comply but we were already looking at a replacement, however this will be later in the year.

Next steps include:

- Appointment of a Data Protection Officer (DPO)
- Training and Awareness programme for all staff
- Update our privacy notices, policies and procedures
- Review of contracts with our data processes (system suppliers)
- Review our internal systems for compatibility with the requirements of GDPR
- Carry out a data inventory and review our retention schedule
- Undertake Data Privacy Impact Assessments (DPIA's) to identify risks
